Salvation Army Adult Rehabilitation Ctr	3-5 Griswold St Binghamton	Provides 60-bed residential for alcohol/drug problems rehabilitation facility for men 21+ yrs. Provides room, board, clothing, counseling, and weekly stipend (6 mos-1 yr).	723-5381
Rise-NY Previously SOS Shelter <i>(For victims of domestic violence and their children)</i>	Confidential location	Provides shelter and residential needs including: food, toiletries, and clothing for women and their families who are victims of domestic violence. Counseling, advocacy, children's program and referral services. Maximum stay of 30 days. 20 beds serving mainly Broome/Tioga counties. Must be alcohol - and drug-free.	754-4340 1-877-754-4340

Volunteers of America <i>Emergency Housing for couples or single parents</i>	Must apply first @ 320 Chenango St Binghamton	Provides one-, two- or three-bedroom furnished apartments for couples or single parents of one or more children. Rentals available to persons rendered homeless for any particular reason. Client services include: assistance in locating safe, clean, affordable permanent housing, and aid in regaining employment.	771-6795
Volunteers of America <i>Emergency Shelter for men</i>	Must apply first 320 Chenango St Binghamton	Provides emergency housing for males (18+ yrs). Residents 18+ yrs involved in development and preparation of their individual treatment plan and provided with clothing and food.	772-1156
YWCA <i>Emergency Housing for women</i>	80 Hawley St Binghamton	Emergency housing for women 18+ yrs and single mothers with 1 or 2 dependent children, willing to follow house rules. (Male children must be under 9 yrs) Assists clients with case management and supportive services.	772-0340 ext 235 ext 238
