RISE (For victims of domestic violence and their children)	<i>Confidential Location</i>	Provides shelter and residential needs including food, toiletries, and used clothing as available for women and their families who are victims of domestic violence . Salvation Army Adult Rehabilitation Center	3-5 Griswold St Binghamton	Provides room/board, clothing and weekly stipend to adults (21+ yrs) up to 90 days. Includes treatment for persons with mental, emotional, alcohol or drug problems; law violators may be paroled directly.	723-5381
"the Y" (YMCA) Emergency Shelter for men	61 Susquehanna St Binghamton	Provides emergency housing for males (18+ yrs). Residents 18+ yrs are involved in development and preparation of their individual treatment plan and provided with clothing and food.	772-0560 ext 336 ext 338
Tioga County Open Door Mission	425 North Ave Owego	Provides 10-bed men's shelter. Also offers temporary emergency housing for families. Alcohol counseling and referrals.	687-1121
