Catholic Charities Gateway Center for Youth (8-21 yrs)	Free and confidential counseling for Broome County youth (8-21 yrs). Parental permission not required, but family involvement is encouraged. Provides assessment, short-term counseling, referral, psycho- educational group counseling (anger management, self- esteem, social skills, and parenting) and coordination of services to youth and their families.	607-729-9166
Christian Counseling Center	Individual, group, marital, family biblically-based counseling. Offer counseling to address depression, addictions, anxiety, trauma, abuse, and relationship issues from a Christian perspective. Private pay; no third-party insurance. Community Treatment & Recovery Center - GBHC	Adult outpatient clinic which offers comprehensive mental health services to individuals with qualifying DSM-IV diagnosis. Self-referrals accepted.	607-797-0680
Family & Children's Counseling Services	Works to help individuals resolve problems, overcome trauma, develop positive relationships and enhance self-esteem. Issues include: anxiety, adolescent/children's issues, anger management, depression, divorce, domestic violence, EMDR, family and marital problems, gay/lesbian issues, parenting, relationships, grief, and post -traumatic stress disorder. Child & Adolescent Behavioral Health Center - GBHC	Offers comprehensive outpatient service for children and adolescents (6yrs-18th birthday). Designed to meet the needs of children who have severe emotional and/or psychiatric illness.	607-773-4520
Inpatient Psychiatric Care/Child & Adolescent - GBHC	Provides comprehensive diagnostic evaluation, treatment and stabilization to children and adolescents (5-17 yrs) who require inpatient psychiatric care and who present a danger to self, family or others in the community.	607-773-4044
