American Red Cross (Disaster only)	620 E Main St Endicott	Provides 24-hr emergency and recovery assistance to victims of disasters, such as hurricanes, floods, or fires. Trained Red Cross interviewers meet one-on-one with individuals and families to determine their disaster-caused needs and provide emergency assistance as the recovery process begins.	607-785-7207

Catholic Charities Teen Transitional Living Program (16 to 21 years)	232 Main St (Office)	Provides a safe and supportive living environment to homeless youth, ages 16 to 21. Serves males, females, LGBTQIA2S+, pregnant and parenting youth and their dependent children.	607-729-9166
Rise-NY Previously SOS Shelter (For victims of domestic violence and their children)	Binghamton	Provides shelter and residential needs including: food, toiletries, and clothing for adults and their children who are victims of domestic violence. Counseling, advocacy, children's program and referral services. Maximum stay of 30 days. 20 beds serving mainly Broome/Tioga counties. YMCA (Emergency Shelter for men)	61 Susquehanna St Binghamton	Provides emergency and transitional housing to men ages 18 and older.	607-772-0560
Volunteers of America (Emergency Shelter for men)	320 Chenango St Binghamton	Emergency housing for homeless unaccompanied males (18+ yrs). Individuals in shelter are provided with meals, and support services.	607-772-1156
UP-Comfort Center	42 Chenango St Binghamton	Provides a safe space for rest, support and resources for those who are unhoused. Clothing and hygiene products available. Sun-Fri 7:00pm-7:00am. First come, first serve beginning at 6:45 pm. No admittance after 9:00 pm unless DSS or Police requested.	607-768-3066
YWCA (Emergency Housing for women)	80 Hawley St Binghamton	Emergency housing includes a 21-day stay for homeless women and 48 permanent supportive housing units.
