To prevent traffic issues, **please do not arrive before 9AM**. Everyone who has registered will receive food.

Due to supply chain shortages, we will not be packing items in boxes, so some items will be loose in your trunk.

You may wish to bring boxes or bags to help you bring them from your vehicle to your house.

You also might not see the same products you are used to receiving at the distribution.

You may pick up food for up to 4 households per vehicle, if you have separate reservation numbers for them and adequate space in your vehicle.

If staff/volunteers determine it will be too difficult to fit items in your vehicle safely, we may not be able to fill all of your reservations.

Make sure you limit the number of people in your car and clean out your trunk to receive food.
